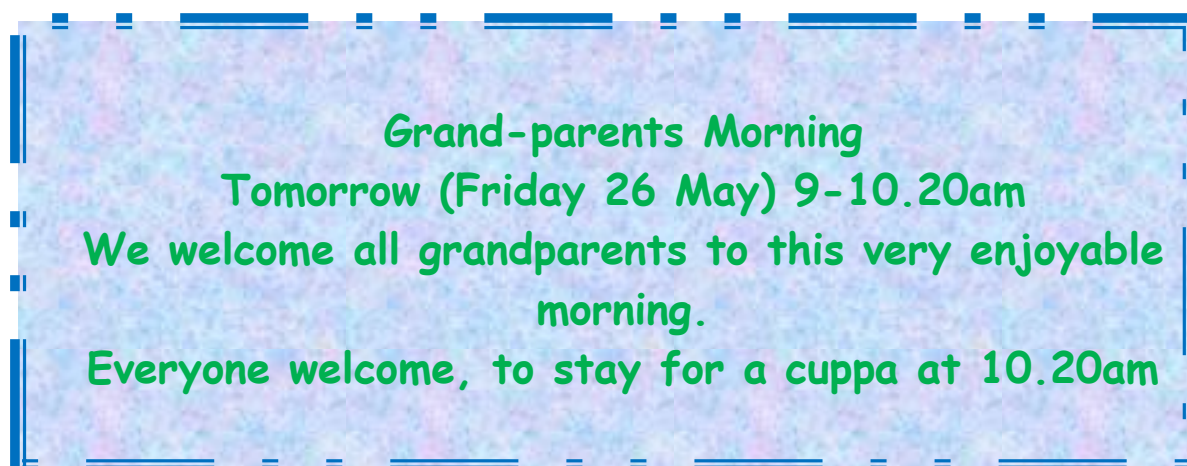

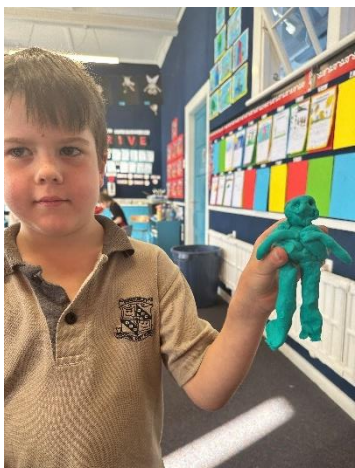
If you don't do bobby's but would like to donate a cull cow instead let us know and this can be arranged too.
