






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School Uniform Procedure



UNIFORM

- School culottes (girls).
- School shorts (boys).
- School polo shirt.
- School sweatshirt.
- · Plain black sandals with a back strap or plain black shoes.
- Plain black socks.
- School hat (terms 1 & 4).
- · School long black trousers (unisex)

OPTIONAL WINTER UNIFORM

- Black long sleeve top, which is to be worn under school polo shirt.
- Full length black stockings.
- Rain jackets of any colour can be worn to and from school and outside during cold break times
- Black beanie and gloves may be worn to and from school and outside during cold break times.

GENERAL APPEARANCE

- Students' hair is to be tidy, off the face and of natural colour.
- · Hair which is shoulder length or longer needs to be tied back.
- No makeup or nail polish.
- A wristwatch may be worn.
- One gold/silver stud or sleeper may be worn in each ear
- Jewellery of cultural significance may be worn.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All belongings must be well named.
- New and second hand school uniform items are available from our school with the exception
 of footwear and optional uniform items.
- Please write a note to the classroom teacher with a valid explanation if your child is not in correct uniform.

CONSEQUENCES IF OUT OF UNIFORM

- Unexplained first time letter/message sent home.
- Unexplained second and further consecutive days child withdrawn from the playground at morning tea to relearn uniform expectations.
- Unexplained incorrect uniform item will be removed if possible (e.g incorrect shoes).
