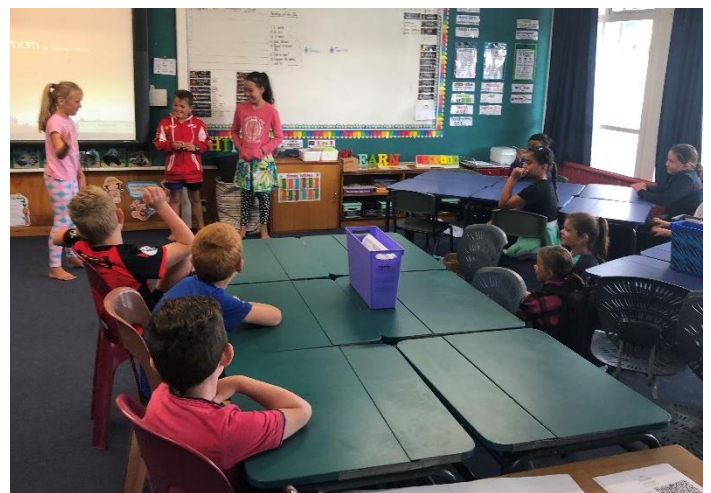
### Friday Cricket

Please return your yellow tops to school with your child.

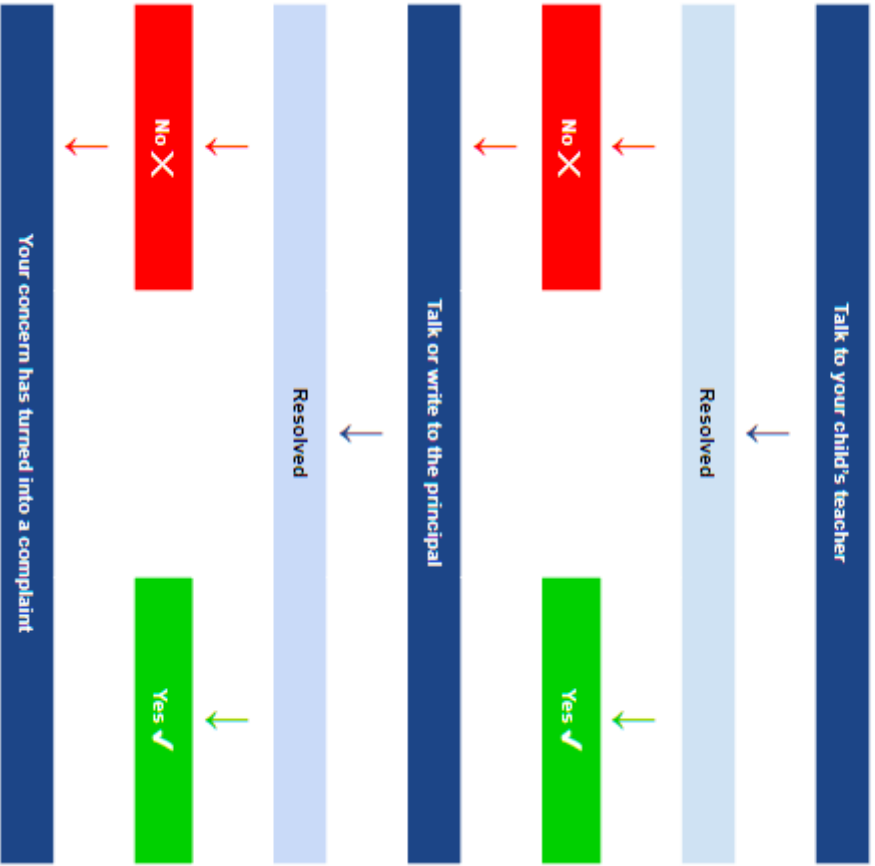
